Through a state-level contract, Smart Start funds enhance the child care subsidy program which provides financial assistance with the cost of high quality child care to families who are working or attending school. Locally, the Smart Start subsidy program is titled "Child Care Advantage" and funds funnel directly through the NHC DSS.

Positive Parenting Program (Triple P) is a prevention and intervention parenting education service to families with children utilizing seminars (Level 2), brief interaction opportunities (Level 2-Brief), and a series of group sessions (Level 4).
