Rainy days can make it harder for children to get their energy out. This workshop focuses on the importance of letting the kids move and hone their gross motor skills, even when it's raining outside. We'll discuss the importance of gross motor skills and why letting children move aid in that development. Teachers will have the opportunity to play games, sing movement songs, and plan activities that are suitable for ages 2 and up.

Mon., May 13 The Power of Loose Parts **PRE**

Your preschool classroom is stocked with just the right kind of books, blocks, and dramatic play props; now let's take a look at the power of loose parts. In this workshop, participants will learn about setting up provocation centers for exploration, even for classrooms on a budget. One thing **YOU** can control is your language and tone of voice—they are powerful tools for early educators. They can create calm or create challenges. In this training, you will learn the difference between various tones of voice, and how to positively shift word choice to effectively communicate with the children in your classroom.

Wed., June 5 & 12 FLIP IT! PRE

Do you want to get to the root cause of behaviors in your classroom to really be able to address them? FLIP IT! (Feelings, Limits, Inquiries, Prompts) gives you the strategies and tools to do that— to use with every child in your classroom. This training teaches participants the four supportive steps of FLIP IT! that are designed to help young children (ages 3-8) learn about their feelings, gain self-control, and reduce challenging behavior. This is a 2-part series. Participants must attend both nights to receive credit. This workshop is designed specifically for preschool teachers. Cost: \$15
